- Enable to input USB to play Music and Movies
- PAS(Parking Assistance System)
- Support full multimedia PIP(Picture in Picture) to maximize convenience
- Enable to switch modes and control system via OEM buttons

2. Button Usage

Press 2 seconds or longer for restart program




Press short, for OEM display

3. How to use

3.1 Main Menu

※ Select menu buttons via Touch screen

Touch the UI to
switch OEM



- ① Battery Voltage: Move to Battery Voltage in Q-SMART
- ② NAVIGATION: Refer to the navigation manual
- ③ Q-SMART(Optional) : N
- ④ Multimedia : For Music, Video, DTV, I-Pod, USB, A2DP features
- ⑤ SETUP : for user environment settings.
(Rear Camera, Volume, Start program language, etc)

3. How to use

3.2 Phone



- ① Contacts: phonebook and call log
- ② Settings : Phone pairing and Phonebook synchronization
- ③ To pick up phone or make phone call.
- ④ To end phone call

※ In order to use Phone function, It is required to have a Blue tooth set(Optional)


3.2 Phone



- ① Call logs (Received voice calls, Dialed voice calls)
- ② Contact list.

3. How to use

3.2 Phone



① Pairing : Press "PAIRING" button and input the password (original setting : 0000), searching device through Bluetooth and choose the phone.

※ Pairing : Connect user's mobile phone with QNAVI

② Device list : To show connected device list

③ Synchronization : To synchronize phone book on the phone and QNAVI.

④ Volume : Adjust call volume.

3.3 Multimedia / Main Menu




- ① Music : Play music on the connected USB
- ② Movie : Play movie files on the connected USB
- ③ TDMB : Play DMB
- ④ External input : Play multimedia files from external device
- ⑤ A2DP(Optional) : Play music from connected mobile phone

3.3 Multimedia / Music Player



- ① PIP function (Music player window and navigation can be shown at the same time)
- ② Saved music list on the device
- ③ Repeat – Repeat playlist, Repeat one music, No repeat
Comprise of 3 modes.
- ④ Shuffle music.
- ⑤ Play previous music
- ⑥ Play / Pause
- ⑦ Play next music
- ⑧ Adjust volume

Note PIP(Picture In Picture)

Existing screen is displayed on the full screen at the same time as one are displayed in inset windows.

3. How to use

3.3 Multimedia / Video Player



- ① PIP function (Video player window and navigation can be shown at the same time)
- ② Saved video list on the device
- ③ Skip to the previous
- ④ Rewind
- ⑤ Play and Pause
- ⑥ Fast Forward
- ⑦ Skip to Next
- ⑧ Adjust Volume

※ MP4 file /480P or 800X480 resolution are advisable.

3.3 Multimedia / TDMB




- ① PIP Function : Enable to see DMB and Navigation at the same time.
- ② List of DMB Channel to play.
- ③ Search DMB / DAB Channel.
- ④ Select either DMB / DAB.
- ⑤ Adjust Volume.

3.3 Multimedia / AV



※ Domestic model doesn't support function ①~⑧

① PIP function (Video player window and navigation can be shown at the same time)

② Turn of AV power

③ Select AV remote control button UP

④ Select AV remote control button DOWN

⑤ Go to previous condition

⑥ Select / OK

⑦ Search available device

⑧ Select AV remote control button RIGHT

⑨ Select AV1 or AV2


4.1 Menu Display




4.3 Version / UPGRADE




4.5 Start Program

5. Trouble Shooting

- When the displayed locations does not match your actual position
 - It will take around 5 minutes to receive the GPS signal after a car turned off.
Please wait for receiving GPS signal.
- No voice direction guide in Navigation
 - Please check the set-up of volume.
- No Image but sound in DMB
 - Please go to a place where the signal of DMB is stable and try it again.
- No Sound in DMB mode
 - Adjust navigation volume in Navigation Set-up,
The sound of DMB shall be set separately .
- No Sound from DMB and Media in QNAVI
 - Please check if Car audio is set to Aux
