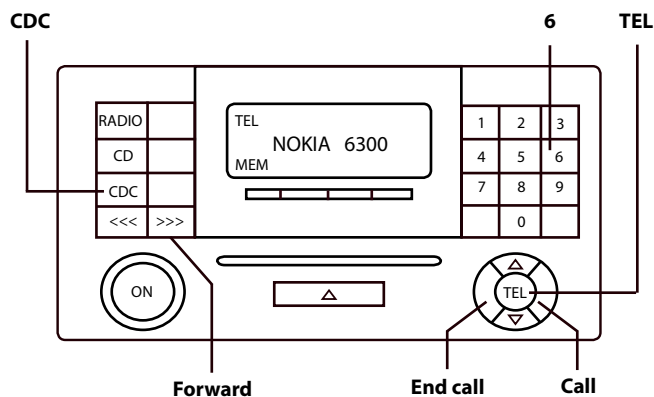


Mercedes Audio 20 Bluetooth quick start guide

This guide provides you with all the information you need to make and receive handsfree phone calls with your Audio 20 system and Dension BTA 1500 module.

You will need to have a Dension Gateway 500 and BTA 1500 correctly installed in and configured for your vehicle. Refer to the relevant Dension user manuals for basic controls. These are the buttons on your Audio 20 system you will use:



1 Pairing your phone and Audio 20 radio

Before you start, make sure your Audio 20 system is switched on and your phone's Bluetooth has been activated (check your phone's user manual for details).

Now you need to 'pair' your phone with your radio. Here's how to do it:

2 Making calls

1. Press the **TEL** button and then dial the number with the number keys on the right of your Audio 20 system

2. Press the **Call** button to make the call. To finish the call, press **End Call**. You can also use the same buttons on your steering wheel.

4 Receiving calls

Receiving a call is the same as making a call. Use the **Call** button to take a call and **End call** button to end a call. Your display will show the number or the name of the caller (if you have the contact stored in your phonebook). Again, you can also use your steering wheel controls.

5 Accessing your phonebook

You can press the **MEM** button to choose contacts from your phonebook. Contacts will be displayed on screen. Simply select a contact and press **Call**.

The first time you pair your phone, it may take up to 10 minutes to download your phonebook to the radio. Every time you re-connect your phone, the radio will look for any new updates before allowing you to make calls.

Please refer to your car's manual for phone controls for your Audio 20.
