

# UniMount

The Dension UniMount allows you to easily mount iPods, mobile phones or any other lightweight items on your dashboard without the use of any adhesives, magnets or screws.

The strips in the UniMount use nanotechnology to create a vacuum which holds any lightweight object with a smooth surface.

# Installation

Do not use excessive force when installing the UniMount! When attaching the UniMount to the air-vent of the vehicle, is recommended that you follow the steps below:

- Slide and if necessary rotate the bottom clips of the UniMount so that the distance of the clips matches the distance of the grill of your air vent.
- Make sure the air vent is open and no underneath mechanical parts block the entry of the clips to the vent.
- Push the UniMount into the vent, making sure that all three clips attach to the grill properly and pushed in as deep as possible.
- Check that the UniMount is firmly attached to the air-vent.

After removing the protective film from the vacuum pads, position and slightly push the object you want to attach to the UniMount to the pads. Please make sure that the surface of the object is dry and clean, since dust, grease, dirt, etc. could prevent the build-up of the required vacuum. Always check that the mounted device holds firmly.

When removing the mounted object it is recommended that you hold the object with one hand and secure the UniMount in the vent with the other. During the first few removals (when the UniMount and the device are very clean) there may be stronger than normal vacuum holding the device.

# Maintenance and Support

When the stickiness of the strips starts to decrease, simply renew it by washing the UniMount in clean water and letting it dry. Do not wipe the vacuum pads.

Caution

- Use the UniMount only with lightweight objects having a smooth surface (like an iPod Nano or similar).
- Check that the vacuum builds up properly before starting your vehicle.
- Do not place the UniMount or any object on the UniMount or any cables connected to such objects near an airbag, steering wheel or any other controls of the car.
- Do not use the UniMount under extreme driving conditions for example off-road driving or racing.
- Avoid using the UniMount on paper, as the paper surface may get damaged.
- Do not use the UniMount with air vents that only allow mounting in a vertical or close to vertical position.
- Do not force the clips into the air-vent, they should attach smoothly and hold firmly.
- Please observe the applicable regulations on the possible use of electronic devices while driving or in the vehicle. Dension does not assume liability for any events resulting from the illegal or irresponsible use of handheld devices while driving.
