


1. Features

(2*Video Input, 1*Rear Camera Input, 1*A/V Out)
- Powerful multimedia features
(Removable storage device and enjoy movie or music file)
- PAS (Parking Assistance System)
- Switching Mode & Controlling the Multimedia via original buttons

2. Button Usage



If Press long this button which placed left of the steering wheel, Can switching mode (In caser of 8" monitor : "NAV" Button)



If press short this button on steering wheel
- Music, Movie : Play next media



If press short this button in steering wheel
- Music, Movie : Play previous media



If Press long this button which placed right of the steering wheel, Can re-boot the system

3. How to use

3.1 Main menu

※ User can touch screen to select the menu.



① GPS

② PHONE : Make phone call through Bluetooth


④ MEDIA : for Music, Video, DTV, USB, A2DP features

⑤ SETUP : for user environment settings.

(Rear Camera, Volume, Start program language, etc)

3.2 Phone / Main menu



- ① Contacts: phonebook and call log
- ② Settings : Phone pairing and Phonebook synchronization
- ③ To pick up phone or make phone call.
- ④ To end phone call

3.2 Phone / Phonebook



- ① Call log (Received voice calls, Dialed voice calls)
- ② Contact list
- ③ When Press long the number, Can Delete the record

3. How to use

3.2 Phone / Settings



① Pairing : Press “PAIRING” button and input the password (original setting : 0000), searching device through Bluetooth and choose the phone.

※ Pairing : Connect user’s mobile phone with QNAVI

② Device list : To show connected device list

③ Synchronization : To synchronize phone book on the phone and QNAVI.

④ Volume : Adjust call volume.

Reference Press  button to move to main menu. (top left side)

3. How to use

3.3 MEDIA / Main menu



- ① MUSIC : Play music on the connected USB
- ② MOVIE : Play movie files on the connected USB
- ③ DVD : Play from DVD
- ④ External input : Play multimedia files from external device
- ⑤ A2DP : Play music from connected mobile phone

3. How to use

3.3 MEDIA / Music



- ① Saved music list on the device
- ② Repeat – Repeat playlist, Repeat one music, No repeat
Comprise of 3 modes.
- ③ Shuffle music.
- ④ Play previous music
- ⑤ Play / Pause
- ⑥ Play next music
- ⑦ Adjust volume

3. How to use

3.3 MEDIA / Video



- ① Saved video list on the device
- ② Play previous media
- ③ Rewind
- ④ Play / Pause
- ⑤ Move forward
- ⑥ Play next media
- ⑦ Adjust volume

3.3 MEDIA / DVD




- ① Power connector between DVD device and car
- ② Move to previous chapter
- ③ Rewind (press once for 10 seconds)
- ④ Play / Pause
- ⑤ Fast-forward (press once for 10 seconds)
- ⑥ Move to next chapter
- ⑦ Stop
- ⑧ Move up DVD changer
- ⑨ Move down DVD changer

3.3 MEDIA / AV



- ① Turn of AV power
- ② Select AV remote control button UP
- ③ Select AV remote control button DOWN
- ④ Go to previous condition
- ⑤ Select / OK
- ⑥ Search available device
- ⑦ Select AV remote control button RIGHT

Factory Menu (only can be set by installer)


③ Volume : Adjust speaker volume


4.2 Rear Camera

④ A/S MODE


- QNAVI : QNAVI Usage




